We look forward to welcoming you.





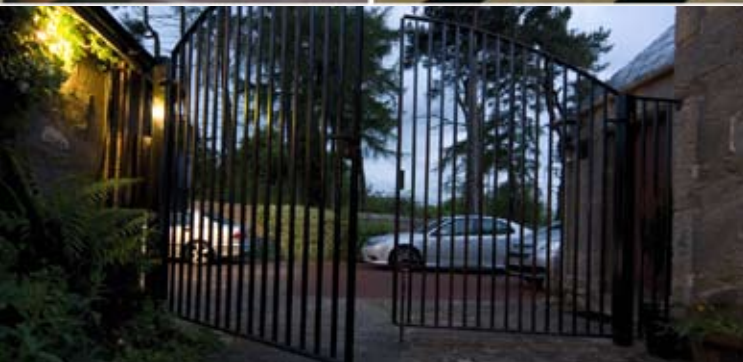
Bed and Breakfast

The Old School is an 18th century stone property with lovely south facing gardens surrounded by woodland in the small conservation village of Newton on the Moor.

The village boasts one of the finest old coaching inns in Northumberland, and it is just a 300 metre walk from The Old School, but don't forget to borrow the torch for your walk back.

We have three first floor double letting rooms and a ground floor business deluxe room, all have en suite facilities with Mira showers. You will find a thoughtful selection of finishing touches and home comforts to enrich your stay.

Breakfast menu

Our breakfast (described as outstanding by the judges of the Enjoy England Excellence Awards) is served at your own table in the dining room. The menu is a mix of traditional and classical dishes, and has a selection of vegetarian and gluten free dishes, but we are always pleased to cater for any other special dietary requests.

The Old School Special

A poached egg on a round of black pudding placed on toasted muffin and topped off with rashers of crisp streaky bacon. Garnished with mushroom and tomato - perfection!

The Old School Platter

The full platter consists of rashers of grilled back bacon, smoked back bacon, Northumbrian pork sausage, black pudding, mushrooms, tomato, sauté potatoes, pot of baked beans and free range egg - fried, scrambled or poached served on a toasted muffin.

Vegetarian Platter

Grilled quorn and pine nut cutlet served with mushrooms, tomato, sauté potatoes, baked beans and free range egg - fried, scrambled or poached served on a toasted muffin.

Cold Platter

Sliced ham or smoked salmon, egg, tomato, smoked cheese and melon.
A warm breakfast roll completes this breakfast.

Eggs Benedict

Poached eggs on ham covered toasted muffins coated with hollandaise sauce.

Omelette Arnold Benett

A flat creamy omelette topped with flaked smoked haddock and grated cheese.
Created by the Savoy Hotel as a supper dish for the playwright Arnold Benett

(1867 - 1931)

However, using locally smoked haddock, it also makes an excellent breakfast.

How to find us

By Road

On the A1 the turn off for Newton on the Moor is sign posted - 13 miles north of Morpeth and 5 miles south of Alnwick. Once you have left the A1 follow the road signs for Swarland and Longframlington (do not follow signs for Swarland and Longframlington before you have left the A1 at the Newton on the Moor turn off). Pass the village hall on your right, and we are the last property on the left, approximately a mile after turning off the A1. Pull in through the white gates and park on the drive.

By Train

The nearest station is six miles at Alnmouth for Alnwick and is served by East Coast and Virgin trains.

A taxi service is based at the station, although car or cycle hire is essential for exploring the local area. See our website for local taxi numbers.

Sat Nav

For Sat Nav users our postcode NE65 9JY covers the whole the village. From the pub - The Cook and Barker Inn follow the signs for Longframlington.
